



### MESSAGE SUMMARY

Bible Reading: Luke 24:13-49

1. They still didn't recognise Jesus. Things didn't happen as they expected, and they had little faith. Is this us?
2. They are reminded of what the Scriptures said. Jesus opens their minds and the Scriptures to point how it all points to Himself. We need to believe ALL of Scripture and continually dive into it, not just for information sake, but because it reveals Jesus.
3. They finally realise who Jesus is, not just through the Scriptures, but also through the 'breaking of bread', through their fellowship and intimacy with Him. They have their 'aha moment'.
4. As their eyes are opened, they are sent out as witnesses. They are excited, overcome with emotions, and head out to share the good news!

### DISCUSSION

**ICE BREAKER:** What did God reveal and remind you of over Easter? What stood out / encouraged you?

**READ:** Luke 24:13-49

- One of the reasons the disciples didn't recognise Jesus is because things didn't happen just like they expected, even though they 'knew' what Jesus said. What does this look like in your life? How do we trust God even when God doesn't do what we want or how we would like?
- What does it mean that all of Scripture points to Jesus; what are the implications? How did you go reading through Luke? How can we dive more into the Bible, knowing it is one of the primary ways God reveals Himself?
- Share a time (or times) when you had an 'aha moment'. How did God open your eyes?  
*Not necessarily your conversion moment, but maybe when something clicked or made sense.*
- Who are you intentionally witnessing to? Where are you being a witness? Are we praying for God to reveal Himself through us?

**PRAY:** Ask God to reveal Himself more to us during this week, as we go through life, gather as believers and dive into His Word. Ask God to lead us as we live as witnesses, to give us courage and faith.
