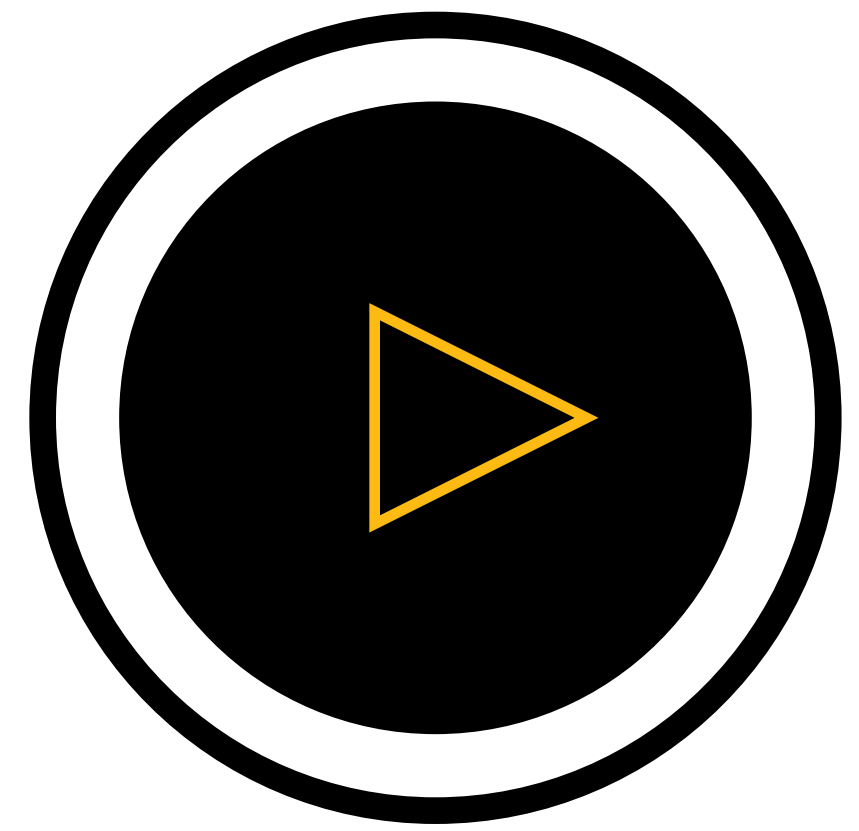

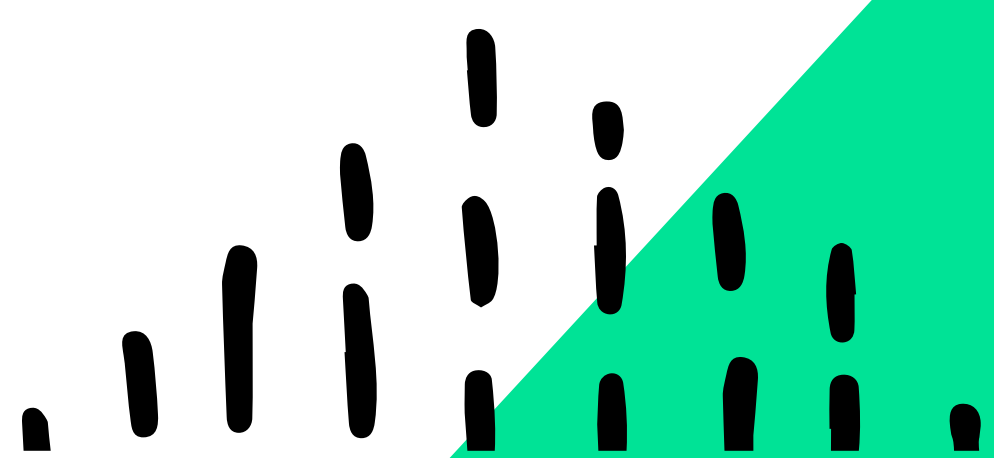

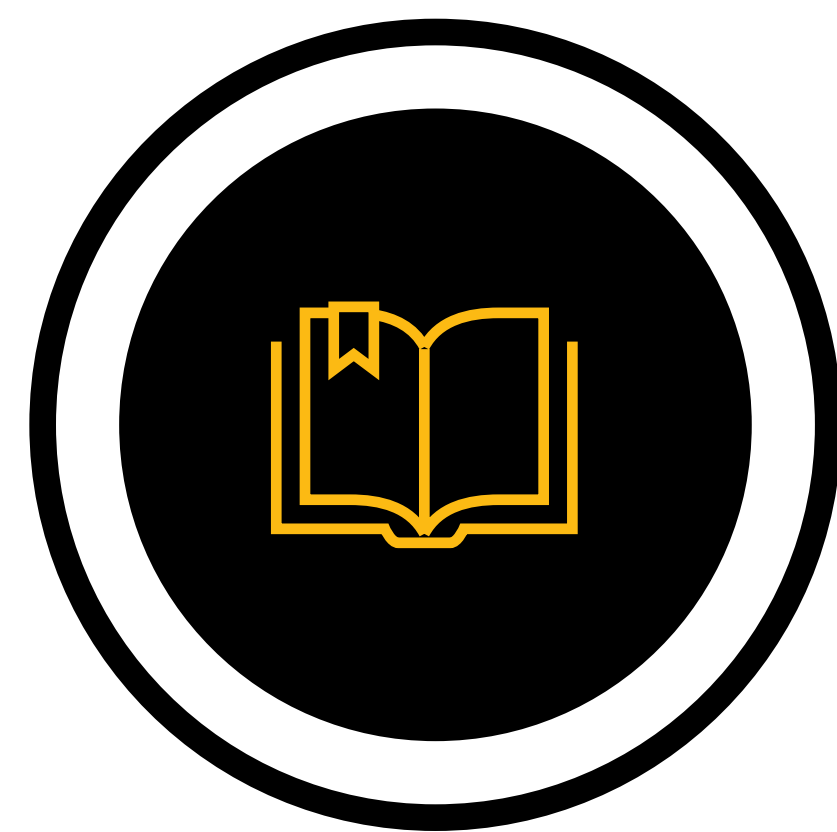

(1 Peter 2:9)

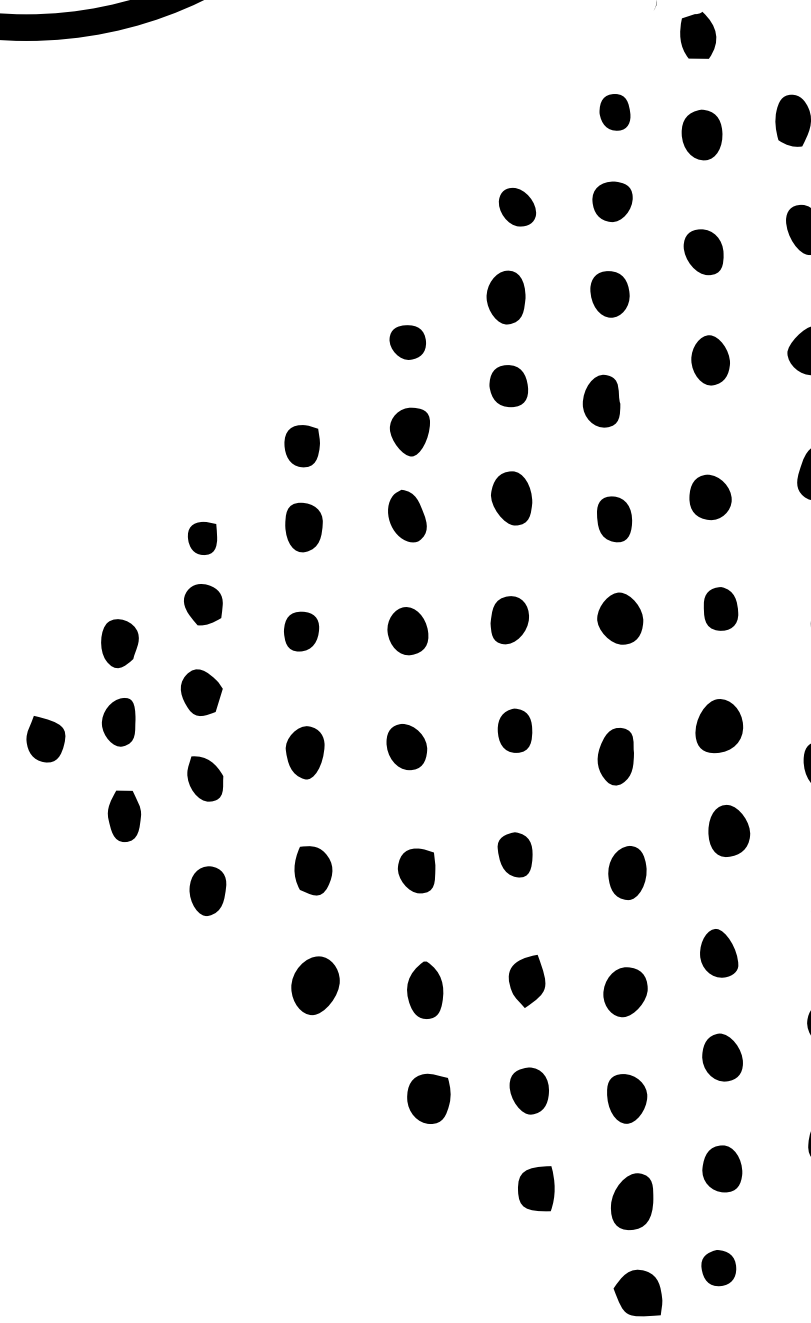

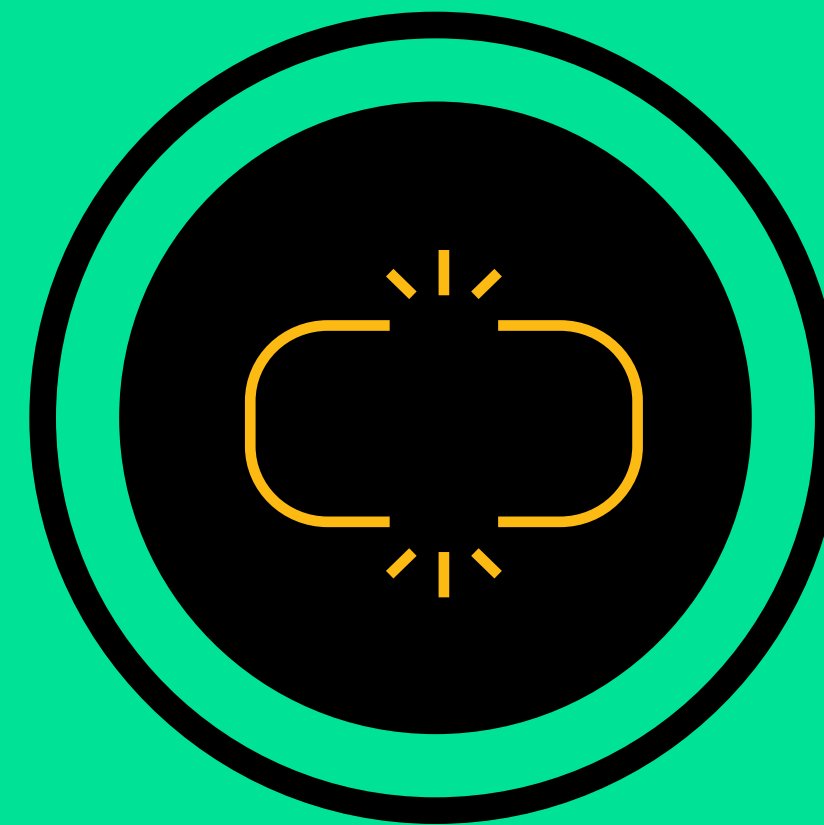

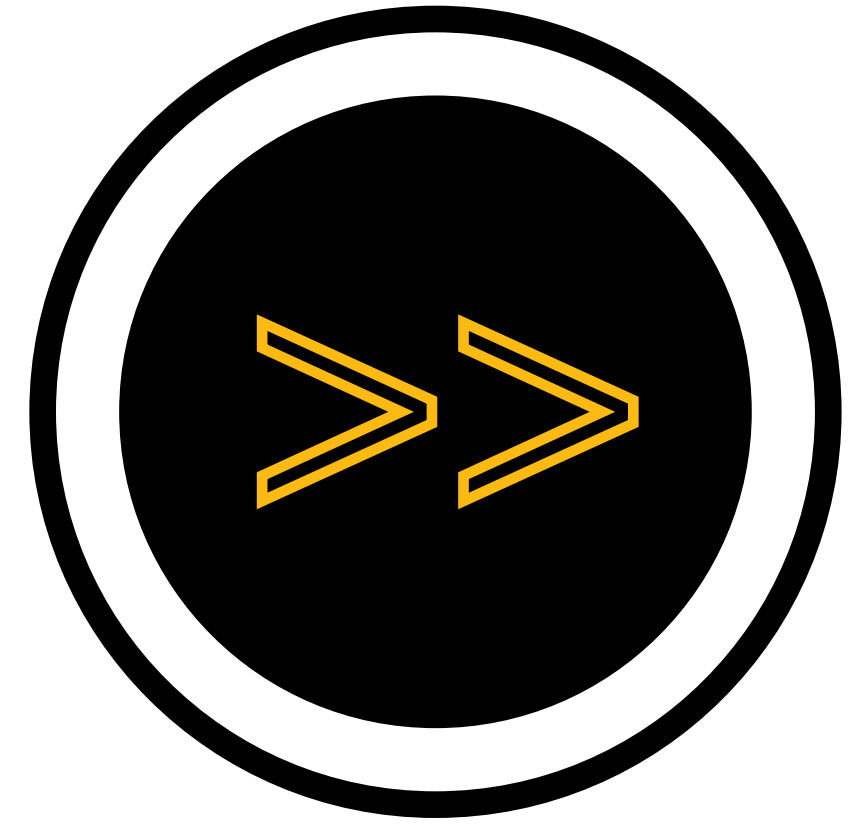
